
Proactive Patrol

PEDICAB WHAT TO KNOW

Non-Motorized Vehicle-For-Hire
Secs. 33-280 thru 33-297, Orange County Code
Effective Date January 1, 2018

Pedicab Vehicles must have a Decal

- Pedicab Owner Decals are issued by the I-Drive District with approved application
- Pedicab Owner must schedule an appointment for inspection of Pedicabs and bring:
 - Completed application
 - Proper payment
 - Certificate of Insurance
 - Pedicab vehicles to be inspected
- After application and inspections are approved, each Pedicab will receive a decal
- Pedicab vehicles must display current decal issued by the I-Drive District at all times



Pedicab Civil Infraction

Code	Description of Violation
33-285(1)	Operation of Pedicab Without Decal – Pedicab may be impounded
33-285(2)	Improper Display of Decal on Pedicab
33-286	Failure to Maintain Proper Insurance
33-287	Failure to Display Rates
33-288 (3)	Failure to Maintain Proper Vehicle Safety and Equipment - Pedicab may be impounded
33-289	Operation of Pedicab without a Driver's Permit
33-291(2)	Improper Display of Driver's Permit
33-293	<p>Engaged in Prohibited Conduct:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Carrying more than maximum number of passengers (2) Collect fares, make change, disembark passengers while in motion (3) Operation that disrupts traffic, failing to yield to pedestrians or failing to give audible signal before passing pedestrians. (4) Operation of the vehicle in any way to place passengers in any position other than upright. (5) Riding more than two abreast, except when passing (6) Allowing passengers to consume alcohol or possess an open container (7) Stopping in location blocking doorways, entrances, driveways, emergency exits or other ingress/egress (8) Selling goods or services unrelated to Pedicab transportation
