


### **Sector 5 Boundaries**





- On 4/19/25 TOPS located a prolific thief after identifying him on video surveillance shortly after a theft occurred at the Walgreens located at 8021 International Dr. The subject was arrested for petit theft with multiple prior convictions.
- On 4/20/25 TOPS conducted a traffic stop which resulted in the seizure of 120 grams of cannabis, drug paraphernalia and 1 arrest.

Non-Motorized Vehicle-For-Hire Secs. 33-280 thru 33-297, Orange County Code Effective Date January 1, 2018

#### Pedicab Vehicles must have a Decal

- Pedicab Owner Decals are issued by the I-Drive District with approved application
- Pedicab Owner must schedule an appointment for inspection of Pedicabs and bring:

Completed application
Proper payment
Certificate of Insurance
Pedicab vehicles to be inspected

- After application and inspections are approved, each Pedicab will receive a decal
- Pedicab vehicles must display current decal issued by the I-Drive District at all times
