RESOLUTION

of the

ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

regarding

INTERNATIONAL DRIVE MASTER TRANSIT AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNIT

Resolution No. 2000-M-49

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 92-M-66 which created the North International Drive Improvement Municipal Service Taxing Unit (the "Taxing Unit"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 92-M-66, the Board of County Commissioners is authorized to levy ad valorem taxes upon taxable real and personal property within the Taxing Unit at rates not in excess of 0.2 mill per annum; and

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Resolution No. 92-M-66 ("Section 5") provided for the abolition of the Taxing Unit on October 1, 1998; and

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Resolution No. 97-M-57 amended Section 5 by extending the date for abolition of the Taxing Unit to October 1, 2000; and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of Resolution No. 92-M-66 ("Section 7") provided for the resolution to be repealed on October 1, 1998; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Resolution No. 97-M-57 amended Section 7 by extending the date for repeal of Resolution No. 92-M-66 to October 1, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners and the Governing Board of the International Drive Master Transit and Improvement District desire to eliminate the dates for abolishment of the Taxing Unit and for repeal of Resolution No. 92-M-66.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Section 5 of Resolution No. 92-M-66, as amended by Resolution No. 97-M-57, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Section 7 of Resolution No. 92-M-66, as amended by Resolution No. 97-M-57, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this resolution which can be given effect without the valid provision or application and to this end the provisions of this resolution are declared severable.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
